UPDATES- GHS Ride Safe Program- Web Site Redesign-Griswold Street -New London Turnpike & Chestnut Hill Road LOTSIP grant improvements.

Road Safety Action Plan- Approval by Town Council

- Jeff recapped the high school gym bicycle classes (that had support from BWG volunteers). Among the activities the students rode around the circumference of the high school.

OLD BUSINESS- DEEP Trail Grant status- Bike route signs- Naubuc Ave. Kiosk at Putnam Bridge walkway- Meeting with Commission on Aging. AARP Grant -Main Street Sidewalk completion

- Town Council approved recommendations from Road Safety Action Plan
- Trails are now all blazed in SMS bike mountain trail system. Working on signs to post. Working on adaptive cycling improvements. E-bikes/dirt-bikes are tearing up the trails -- BAG to take up with police.
- Still waiting on decision on DEEP park improvements for the Marlborough road area
- Working with Park and Rec on Kiosk for Naubuc Avenue

- Main Street sidewalks (to Chestnut Hill) are nearing completion
